BEATING THE HEAT

Keeping Your Feline Friend Safe and Cool in the Summer



As the summer sun shines brightly, it's important to ensure that our furry feline friends stay safe and comfortable during the hot months. Cats are susceptible to heat-related illnesses, and need to take proactive measures to protect them.

Here are some essential tips to keep your cat safe and cool during the summer heat:

1. Provide Ample Hydration

Just like humans, cats need to stay hydrated, especially in warmer weather. Ensure that your cat always has access to fresh, cool water. Consider placing multiple water bowls around your home and keep them refilled throughout the day. You can also add ice cubes to the water to help keep it cooler for longer.

2. Create Cool Retreats

Offer your cat shaded areas where they can relax and escape the heat. Set up a cozy space indoors with comfortable bedding near a window, but away from direct sunlight.

3. Keep Indoor Temperatures Comfortable

Maintain a comfortable indoor temperature for your cat. Ensure that your home is adequately cooled during hot days. Even with air conditioning, a small fan blowing on your cat's sleeping area will create a cool spot.

4. Limit Sun Exposure

Cats can easily get sunburned, particularly those with light-colored fur or exposed skin. Keep your blinds closed when possible!

5. Never Leave Your Cat in a Parked Car

Leaving your cat in a parked car, even for a few minutes, can be extremely dangerous. Cars heat up rapidly, and the temperature inside can become life-threatening for your feline companion. Always take your cat with you or leave them at home in a cool, safe environment.

6. Grooming and Fur Care

Regular grooming helps to keep your cat's coat in good condition and aids in temperature regulation. Brush your cat's fur to remove excess hair and prevent matting, which can impede proper airflow. Never shave your cat - a good groomer can help with excessively matted fur.

7. Play and Exercise Wisely

Engage in play and exercise activities with your cat during the cooler parts of the day, such as early morning or evening. Avoid strenuous activities during the hottest times to prevent overheating. Indoor interactive toys and puzzle feeders are excellent alternatives to keep your cat mentally stimulated and physically active without exposing them to excessive heat.

8. Watch for Signs of Heat Stress

Be vigilant for signs of heat stress in your cat, such as excessive panting, lethargy, drooling, rapid breathing, and vomiting. If you notice any of these symptoms, move your cat to a cooler area immediately and contact your veterinarian immediately!

This information is general only. For heat related issues contact your veterinarian.
