Saving our Feline Friends Skye and Danny

Meet Skye! This incredible 10 year old boy was relinquished to Friends of Cats and upon his return, we quickly noticed a pronounced limp in his back left leg. Our primary vet performed an x-ray and examination, revealing a large mass occupying most of his upper thigh. Given the mass's size, a standard amputation wouldn't suffice; he required a specialized surgery to remove his entire leg up to the pelvic bone. Thanks to the expertise of All God's Creatures Teaching Hospital & Surgery Center, Skye underwent a successful amputation in March. The biopsy confirmed the mass was cancerous, but the timely surgery saved his life by preventing the cancer from spreading. Now, Skye is thriving at the shelter and has made a full recovery.





Danny

Meet Danny! This extraordinary 1 1/2 year old boy lives with a rare condition in cats, known as an Intraphetic Liver Shunt. Most cats with this condition struggle to reach adulthood, but Danny is defying the odds. His liver has a vein that bypasses its natural function, allowing toxins to build up in his body instead of being filtered out. So far, we've been able to manage his condition with medication. However, if this approach ever fails, our last resort would be a highly risky and costly surgery to block the shunt, a procedure that could only be performed at UC Davis. Despite his challenges, Danny is a quirky and endearing character. At Friends of Cats, Danny, Skye and other sanctuary cats like them, will always receive the lifetime care they need.

Celebrating 95 Years!




