The mission of Friends of Cats has remained the same for over 90 years: Place healthy cats in adoptive homes and maintain a sanctuary for those cats with health issues.

We provide a loving environment for cats where the owners can longer care for them. Euthanasia is only chosen when a veterinarian deems the condition no longer treatable and determines the cat is suffering.

Our donors support the daily care of the cats and also provide the foundation for improvements to the shelter that benefit the cats.

DONOR ASSISTED IMPROVEMENTS IN PROGRESS:

INSTALL SECURITY CAMERAS

Security of our 2 legged cat caregivers as well as the cats is a high priority. With the shelter manned 24 hours a day, 6-8 outside cameras will help us see the property day and night. In addition, seeing the property can be extremely important in fire season. We hope to have this completed shortly

UPGRADE THE "KITTEN COTTAGE"

For the best health of new mamas and babies, they should be kept separate from the general population of cats. We have currently started remodeling a separate area and plan on updating the floor and walls. We hope to have this completed before early spring, (Kitten season).


DONOR ASSISTED PROJECTS FOR THE FUTURE:

UPGRADE HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING

For our Special Buildings including Lifetime Care, and FIV and FELV annexes.

HOSPITAL RENOVATION

We have been able to upgrade the hospital kitchen due to generous donors. Blood testing, quarantine for new arrivals, and recovery from illnesses take place in the hospital area. Our most vulnerable population of diabetic, blind, or chronically ill cats are treated here. We plan to do this in steps: replacing floors, repairing plumbing, and repainting.

Friends of Cats staff include trained Vet techs. However, we have no veterinarian or veterinary services on site. Our relationship with Steele Canyon Veterinary Clinic www.steelecanyonvet.com and Dr. Christine Wilson fills that need.

Dr. Wilson has been a practicing Veterinarian since 1987. It was shortly after that we started our

relationship with Dr. Wilson. In the late 1980's she could be seen volunteering at the shelter with her first child, Sydney in tow.

Working at a Veterinary clinic in Spring Valley that was serving Friend of Cats from 1987-2001, Dr. Wilson came to know the shelter well.

In 2001, when Dr. Wilson opened Steele Canyon Veterinary Clinic, that relationship was renewed shortly afterward.

Dr. Wilson tells us she appreciates Friends of Cats as a shelter that provides a safe shelter for cats. She believes both staff and volunteers for the shelter take great care of the cats. She also believes that the Friends of Cats Med Techs are responsible for her successful treatment of the shelter cats.
